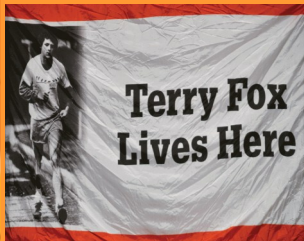
## Terry Fox School Run

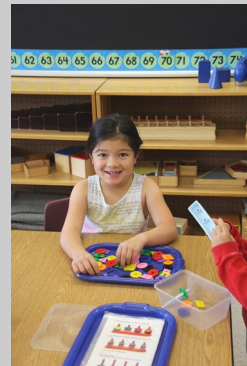
