Canada Wide Early Learning and Child Care (CWELCC) (\$10/day Childcare)



At Town Centre Private Schools, our Toddler, Casa NT and Casa programs are eligible for the CWELCC Program. We are pleased to inform that we are officially enrolled in the (\$10/day Childcare) Program. The

CWELCC program will affect the tuition payments for only our **Toddler, Casa NT** and **Casa programs**. Parents enrolled in Toddler, Casa NT and Casa programs will get a 25% refund retro-active to April 1s 2022. At this time, we have not been informed as to when we will receive the funding from York Region. As soon as we have more details we will pass on that information.

TCPS Toy Drive and Food Drive


Elementary Bullying Prevention and Awareness Week
