## Re-Registration Week - Extended!

We are happy to inform you that the re-registration deadline has been extended to **Tuesday, February 15th**. We would also like to take this opportunity to thank all of our parents who registered early, reserving a place for the 2022-2023 school year.

For parents and guardians who are paying the full school year tuition in one lump sum, the following discounts are available:

- ◆ A discount of 8% for full tuition payments received by February 15, 2022.
- ◆ A discount of 4% for full tuition payments received by April 1, 2022.
- ◆ A discount of 2% for full tuition payments received after April 1, 2022.

**\$500 Off Grade 1 Tuition:** For all students entering grade 1, we are offering one time \$500 discount on their tuition. This discount is only for students entering grade 1. This discount is available if they register before April 1st and with all methods of payment.

## Resuming After School Courses at Amarillo Campus - January 31st

We are happy to announce that we have resumed the After School Courses at Amarillo Campus as of Monday, January 31st.

The end of the After School Courses - Term 1 will be delayed by four weeks to accommodate the pause of the courses from January 3rd to January 28th.

Following is the new timeline:




### Montessori Education Week - February 22nd - 25th
