This remarkable achievement brings our total contribution to the Terry Fox Foundation to \$256,201.48 since 2006, reflecting the steadfast dedication and generosity of our TCPS community.

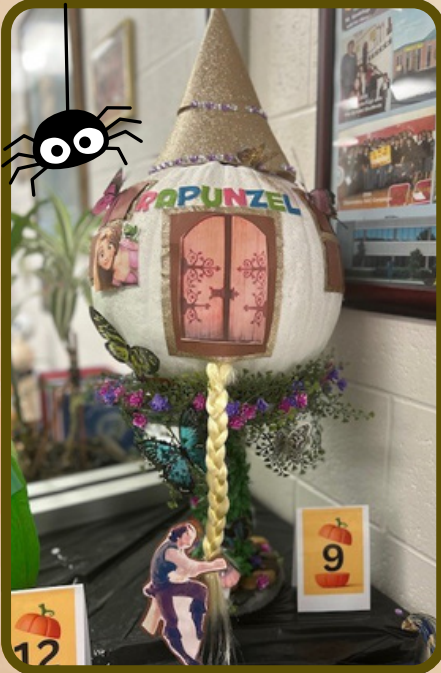
Please be aware that Markham municipal officers are patrolling the parking lot and will issue tickets to those parked inappropriately.
