# **Re-Registration Week - Thank you!**

We appreciate all families who have already re-registered! Thank you for your continued support! If you haven't re-registered yet, there's still time to take advantage of our extended discounts.

The following discount options are applicable for parents opting for the Full Payment Option:

- An \*8% discount is available for full tuition fee payments received by February 3rd, 2025.
- A 4% discount is available for full tuition fee payments received by April 1, 2025.
- A 2% discount is applicable for full tuition payments received after April 1, 2025.

Please be advised that after this date, the regular discount structure will be in effect.

For parents utilizing the Monthly Payment Option, a \$100 discount off the last month's deposit (June 2026) is provided if payment is received by April 1, 2025. Please note that this discount will not be available after April 1st.

We encourage you to re-register now to secure your child's place for the next school year. Spaces are limited and waiting lists are anticipated.

## Black History Month "Black Legacy and Leadership: Celebrating Canadian History and Uplifting Future Generations."



Each year, Black History Month is an opportunity to celebrate the achievements of Black communities in Canada, listen to their stories, and learn more about their history and contributions to Canadian society.

TCPS will continue to recognize and honour Black History Month in February. Our focus this year will be on education and raising more awareness through teacher and student-led events and activities that will help to deepen our understanding and appreciation of the significance of this important month.

### Echos of Excellence (Grade 2-4)

As part of our Black History Month initiatives, Grade 2-4 classes will be presenting short, radio-style announcements over the PA system to educate our school community about significant Black Canadians. Each class will research and create a brief script highlighting their assigned individual's contributions and achievements. Selected students will present their class's announcement during homeroom. This is a great opportunity for our young learners to develop their voices and share important stories with the school!

### Door Displays of Excellence (Grade 5-8)

Grade 5-8 students will be creating informative door displays to highlight the contributions of influential Black Canadians. Working in groups, students will research and creatively present key achievements and the impact of their assigned individuals. These displays will be completed by February 24th and will serve as an educational showcase for the school.

Students in Grades 2-8 will have the opportunity to participate in a gallery walk to explore the displays, with younger students engaging in a scavenger hunt activity to deepen their learning. This initiative encourages collaboration, creativity, and a deeper appreciation of Black history in Canada.

We look forward to seeing their creativity and learning come to life, and honouring Black History Month.
