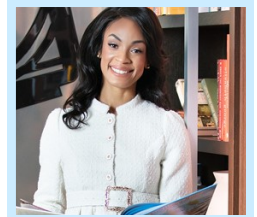



Spring Scholastic Book Fair

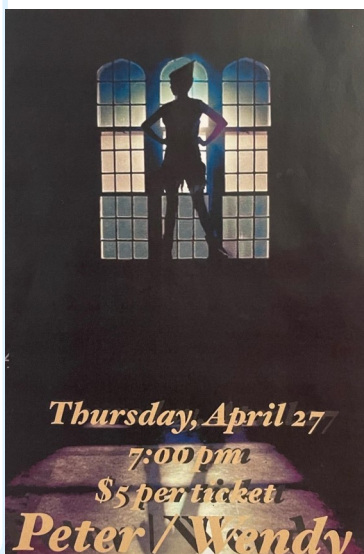
