

Canada-Wide Science Fair

At the York Region Science and Technology Fair hosted by York University, Safia won the **Gold Medal** for her project, **Candies to Dye For,** and qualified to participate in the Canada-Wide Science Fair in Fredericton, NB. Safia received a Travel Award of more than \$2000. In May, Safia participated in the Canada-Wide Science Fair as one of approximately 500 top Canadian young scientists from grades 7 to 12. InSchoolwear Uniform

Over the past 2 years, we have been phasing in the new uniform from InSchoolwear. Starting September 2019, all elementary TCPS students must wear the approved school uniform from InSchoolwear. Students will no longer be able to wear old uniform items previously purchased from Halperns or Beatties. Please visit the display case near the front foyer to view the official uniform. **New for September 2019, grades I to 6 girls will have the option to wear pants or a kilt.** InSchoolwear is currently offering a special save the tax promotion. *Note: Due to current inventory levels, grades I to 6 students can wear the TCPS crested or monogrammed shirts for the next school year. With the phasing in of the new crested shirt, all back ordered shirts for grades I to 6 will include the crest.

- TCPS hoodie (required for Gym and SSAF)

Instrument Return Day
