- 1. Monday, Dec. 16 is our annual Holiday Luncheon and Dance. Dress is "semi-formal"; students may wear their luncheon attire all day if they wish to avoid changing. Morning classes (periods 1, 2 and 3A) will run as scheduled. Afternoon classes will be cancelled.
